

Work on multiple agro projects starts in Balochistan

QUETTA: Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) Central Vice President, Fehmida Kausar Jamali said work has been initiated in Balochistan on multiple agro projects with the aim to enhance the production in the province through modern technologies.

Talking to President (Elect) Gawadar Chamber of Commerce Mir Naveed Baloch, she said 27 previous agriculture projects were underway at the cost of Rs37,212 million, while 16 new ones having estimated cost of Rs2,905 million were undertaken during the current year.

Under Kachhi Canal Area Development Project, 37,877 acres of land

connected to one to 10 distribution would be made cultivable under phase-I of the project costing Rs1,670 million.

She said Balochistan was not only blessed with natural resources but huge benefits could also be accrued by developing its fisheries and livestock sectors. The work on 110-km-long two-lane road from Khuzdar to Bisma was in full swing while work on the N-30 highway began in October 2019. The construction of N-30 highway will cost Rs 19 billion. Similarly 20% work of the highway has been completed, this highway will connect Khuzdar to N85, with the completion of the project in 2021, and access to Gwadar will be easier. "Western route of the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) will en-

hance connectivity and will also develop the deprived areas of Balochistan", she added.

However President GCCI stressed the need for construction of small dams in the province to overcome the water shortage. Gwadar has been blessed with important geo-strategic location," he said, adding that its people would get benefit from its development.

PESHAWAR: Provincial Minister for Local Government, Elections and Rural Development, Akbar Ayub Khan on Tuesday directed for opening one-window operation in all offices of administrators of Tehsil Municipal and establishing a help desks for addressing grievances of general public on urgent basis.

He also directed the establishment of a complaint cell at every union council level so that grievances of the general public could reach the high authorities and the same were addressed on priority basis.

He expressed these views while presiding over a review meeting of Town-1 Peshawar. MPA KP Assembly, Asif Khan, Secretary Local Council Board, Khizar Hayat, Tehsil Municipal Officer Town 1, Ehsanullah and high officials were present on the occasion.

The minister issued directives that special attention should be paid towards cleanliness and beautification of Peshawar and soil alongside the city roads should immediately be removed. He said roadsides and areas with under head bridges be beautified with greenery and flower plants.

During the visit, the minister also went to Shahi Bagh, Parda Bagh and Shalimar Bagh and directed for paying special attention towards parks reserved for families and females. He also directed the renaming of Shalimar Bagh as Shalimar Ladies Park. Akbar Ayub inspected the library in Shahi Bagh and directed for installation of an air-conditioning system and computers for students to provide them a conducive atmosphere. The minister on the occasion issued directives to officials of TMA Town-1 to install sufficient number of drinking water tanks to facilitate the

general public and construct washrooms at appropriate places for public convenience.

He said best material should be used in beautification projects of city parks and keeping in view public convenience, walking tracks, sitting facilities and other services should be made available. He said we had to provide a healthy atmosphere to the people.

Some nurses are also staff whose



credentials are fake. Apart from this, the patient enters the hospital, some corrupt staff order additional medicines for the patient's family, which later returns to the hospital based pharmacy and put money in his pocket. Many such cases have been found in which corruption has been found.

The newly appointed Medical Superintendent said that when I saw the check and balance of everything and asked for a calculation from the corrupt mafia, all the thieves gathered together and

threatened the rest of the staff and protested with them.

1 million COVID-19 deaths 'an agonising milestone': UN Chief



GENEVA: The World Health Organization (WHO) described the 1 million deaths from COVID-19 as an "agonising milestone", even as infections continue to rise. The number of deaths from the novel coronavirus this year is now double the number of people who die annually from malaria - and the death rate has increased in recent weeks as infections surge in several countries. "Our world has reached

an agonising milestone," UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres said in a statement. "It's a mind-numbing figure. Yet we must never lose sight of each and every individual life. They were fathers and mothers, wives and husbands, brothers and sisters, friends and colleagues."

It took just three months for COVID-19 deaths to double from half a million, an accelerating rate of fatalities since the

first death was recorded in China in early January. More than 5,400 people are dying around the world every 24 hours, according to Reuters calculations based on September averages, overwhelming funeral businesses and cemeteries.

That equates to about 226 people an hour, or one person every 16 seconds. In the time it takes to watch a 90-minute football match, 340 people die on average. —AFP

Fire rips through California wine country, thousands flee



SANTA ROSA: Thousands of people were forced to flee their homes in California's Napa Valley as wildfires fanned by fierce winds ripped through the region's world-famous wine country.

Under an opaque orange sky and a sweltering new heatwave, vineyards were consumed and houses devastated by the blaze that erupted at a "dangerous rate of spread" through 4,500ha by Monday, Cal Fire said.

Celebrated Napa wineries have already gone up in smoke, such as Chateau Boswell and part of Castello di Amorosa, while other vineyards like Merus Wines and Davis Estates were under imminent threat from the fast-moving flames, ac-

cording to local reports.

"We saved the winery last night, but everything else was lost," Tuck Beckstoffer, president of a 8ha vineyard near St Helena, told Wine Spectator magazine on Monday.

Calistoga, a picturesque community at the top of the Napa Valley known for hot springs and as a launchpad for wine tours, has largely been evacuated. —AFP

Cruise ship with reported virus infections docks at Greek port

ATHENS: The first cruise ship to sail to Greece since the coronavirus lockdown docked at the port of Piraeus early after a dozen crew members were reported positive for the virus, state news agency ANA said.

The Maltese-flagged Mein Schiff 6, operated by German travel giant TUI, is carrying 922 passengers and 666 crew.

Nobody will be allowed to disembark as testers from Greece's public health agency embarked for inspection. The Greek coastguard said on Monday that 12 crew members had tested positive, although TUI Cruises said that they were asymptomatic.

However, Greek media on Tuesday reported that follow-up tests on the same



crew members turned out negative. The passengers had originally been given a clean bill of health after undergoing tests prior to the voyage, the Greek coastguard said on Monday.

The cruise ship had sailed from the Cretan port of Iraklio on Sunday evening and was heading to Piraeus.

But it halted at the Aegean island of Milos on Monday after the infections were detected, before being rerouted to Piraeus.

The ship was the first to return to Greek waters after lockdown measures imposed in March. Our comprehensive coverage of the coronavirus outbreak and its developments. —AFP
