ISLAMABAD: President Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK) Sardar Masood Khan on Saturday said that the Kashmiri-Pakistani diaspora community has played a critical role in creating awareness about the Kashmir issue and it has acted as a bridge between the people of Kashmir and the international community.

KASUR: A cruel father threw his innocent five children in BS Link canal Pattoki, the accused father Ibrahim has been arrested here on Saturday.

98 percent targets of polio vaccination drive achieved

ISLAMABAD: Polio Eradication Initiative (PEI) on Saturday said that 98 percent targets have been achieved from the five-day national polio immunization drive.

According to an official of Polio Eradication Initiative, the immunization drive was started on November 30 to vaccinate over 39 million children under the age of five years across the country. He added around 285,000 polio frontline workers visited house-to-house, observing strict SOPs for COVID-19, to ensure protection of children from the crippling

polio virus. Special Assistant to the Prime Minister, National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination, Dr Faisal Sultan said, "The government is committed to make Pakistan Polio-free. We are determined to close the immunity gap in children which had unfortunately widened because of disruption of essential services due to COVID-19 pandemic."

He said, "Ensuring timely and repeated vaccination of children is critical for us to reduce the immunity gap and protect them against polio."

Dr Faisal said, "I am confident, together we will achieve our target of

making a safer, healthier and polio-free Pakistan for our children."

Moscow starts mass COVID-19 vaccination with its Sputnik V shot

MOSCOW: Moscow began distributing the Sputnik V COVID-19 shot via 70 clinics marking Russia's first mass vaccination against the disease, the city's coronavirus task force said.

The task force said the Russian-made vaccine would first be made available to doctors and other medical workers, teachers and social workers because they ran the highest risk of exposure to the disease.

"You are working at an educational institution and have top-priority for the COVID-19 vaccine, free of charge," read a phone text message received by one Muscovite, an elementary school teacher, early on Saturday and seen by Reuters.

Moscow, the epicentre of Russia's coronavirus outbreak, registered 7,993 new cases overnight, up from 6,868 a day before and well above the daily tallies of around 700 seen in early September. "Over the first five hours, 5,000 people signed up for the jab - teachers, doctors, social workers, those who are today risking their health and lives the most," Mayor Sergei Sobyenin wrote on his personal website on Friday.

The age for those receiving shots is capped at 60. People with certain underlying health conditions, pregnant women and those who have had a respiratory illness for the past two weeks are barred from vaccination. Russia has developed two COVID-19 vaccines, Sputnik V which is backed by the Russian Direct Investment Fund and another developed by Siberia's Vector Institute, with final trials for the both yet to be completed.

Scientists have raised concerns about the speed at which Russia has worked, giving the regulatory go-ahead for its vaccines and launching mass vaccinations before full trials

to test its safety and efficacy had been completed.

The Sputnik V vaccine is administered in two injections, with the second dose expected to be given 21 days after the first.

Moscow closed down all public places including parks and cafes, with exception for delivery, in late March, with police patrolling the streets looking for those violating the rules. Restrictions were eased from mid-June, however. Russia as a whole reported 28,782 new infections on Saturday, its highest daily tally, pushing the national total to 2,431,731, the fourth-highest in the world. —AP

Mine collapse in Nicaragua traps 10 workers

MANAGUA, Nicaragua: A mudslide in an unlicensed gold mine in Nicaragua trapped at least 10 workers state-run media reported.

Crews began work to try to rescue the miners after the incident in the La Esperanza region of southern Nicaragua.

Vice President Rosario Murillo, who is also the government spokeswoman, did not say how many miners were in the shaft when it collapsed or if there were fatalities.

"We hope not to have bad news," she said, according to the government news site El 19 Digital.

The independent newspaper La Prensa quoted witnesses as saying at least 15 people are trapped in the mine.

In Nicaragua an estimated 3,000 people work in unlicensed mines. —AFP

Iran's visur deaths pass 50,000 as lockdown on capital



TEHRAN: Iran's death toll from the global pandemic has risen above 50,000, according to state television, as the country grapples with the worst outbreak in the Middle East.

A two-week partial lockdown in the capital of Tehran and other major cities helped slow, but not stop the rising wave of deaths from the coronavirus over the past few weeks.

President Hassan Rouhani warned Saturday (Dec 5) that the lockdown could be extended to more cities or reimposed on

the capital, if people do not abide by health measures.

"Tehran is on the borderline of being in the red zone," Rouhani said. "All people and public officials should try to implement measures and regulations."

Health Ministry spokeswoman Sima Sadat Lari said Saturday that the countrywide death toll the previous day was 321.
