

# Educational activities resume at AJK University after 18 months



**MUZAFFARABAD:** The University of Azad Jammu and Kashmir (UJK) reopened after 18 months closure due to the coronavirus pandemic. The university along with other educational institutions was closed in March 2020 due to the growing coronavirus cases and imposition of lockdown in AJK.

When the lockdown was prolonged, the university adopted virtual and technology-based alternative means to save the precious time and the academic year of students. The decision to reopen

the university for on-campus classes was taken on Friday at the meeting of the heads of different departments chaired by Vice-Chancellor, Professor Dr. Muhammad Kaleem Abbasi at King Abdullah Campus of the university. The meeting discussed in detail the arrangements for the resumption of physical classes and other necessary matters including Corona SOPs to be adopted after the reopening of the institution. Some important administrative decisions to address the problems and

issues at the newly constructed King Abdullah Campus of the university were also taken in the meeting.

Addressing the meeting Vice-Chancellor Dr. Muhammad Kaleem Abbasi said that the King Abdullah Campus equipped the educational facilities of international standard was a gift from the Saudi government and the Higher Education Commission to the people of Azad Kashmir, which would not only bring about an educational revolution in AJK but would also change the economic destiny of the people of the region.

He said that the reopening of the university after a long interval poses a big challenge for the management and faculty members of the university to redouble their efforts to make up the educational loss caused during the past one and half years due to coronavirus. He urged the heads of the departments and Deans of various faculties to hold meetings with the teachers of their respective departments, review the problems





# CM for issuing NOCs to investors within given deadline

**PESHAWAR:** Chief Minister Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Mahmood Khan while taking stern notice of unnecessary delay in the issuance of NOCs for private sector investment including the construction of high rise buildings, has directed the concerned quarters for visible steps to ensure the issuance of such NOCs within the given timelines as prescribed in the relevant rules/by-laws and to extend maximum facilitation to private investors to encourage them for maximum investment in the province.

He has said that the provincial government had promulgated laws and put in place regularity regime for attracting maximum private sector investment adding that implementation of those laws in letter and spirit is the foremost responsibility of the concerned departments and entities.

He has warned that in case of any negligence, or any unnecessary hurdle for private investment, the responsible ones would be taken to task and no one would be spared. He was chairing a meeting of Local



Government and Rural Development Department held here.

Besides Chief Secretary Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Dr. Kazim Niaz and Additional Chief Secretary Shahab Ali Shah, Administrative Secretaries of concerned departments, Commissioner Peshawar, Director General Peshawar Development Authority and other senior officials also attended the meeting. Expressing serious concerns on the performance of tehsil municipal Administrations and other subordinate entities of the local government department regarding the issuance of NOCs for commercial

buildings; the chief minister said that hurdles were being created instead of facilitation for private investors at lower level which cannot be tolerated.

He termed ease of doing business and maximum facilitation to the investors as an integral part of his government vision to attract private investment and said that all the concerned departments and entities will have to ensure implementation of government's vision. Mahmood Khan maintained that the provincial government has made effective legislations to attract private sector investment with the aim to create maximum job opportunities for the people which are only possible when the investors are encouraged with maximum facilitation.

He made it clear that the relevant departments and entities are required to ensure cent percent implementation of those laws and rules to achieve the purpose for which they are meant adding that otherwise strict action would be initiated against the responsible ones. —APP

# Pandora Papers revelations: EU must do more says Von der Leyen

'Tax evasion and aggressive tax planning is completely unacceptable'



**LONDON:** The European Union must do more to combat tax evasion and aggressive tax planning, EU Commission President Ursula von der Leyen said Monday in the wake of revelations in the "Pandora Papers". Speaking during a visit to Helsinki, von der Leyen condemned the practices brought to light in the huge data leak, which detailed how 35 current and former world leaders have used offshore tax havens to stash assets worth hundreds of millions of dollars.

"Tax evasion and aggressive tax planning is completely unacceptable," von der Leyen said.

"We have in the European Union some of the highest tax transparency standards in the world, but as we see it's not enough, more work is needed." The documents, known as the "Pandora Papers", were obtained by the International Consortium of Investigative Journalists (ICIJ) and released in stories by media partners

including The Washington Post, the BBC and The Guardian. Allegations range from corruption to money laundering and tax avoidance. Although holding assets offshore or using shell companies is not illegal in most countries, the revelations are embarrassing for leaders who have pushed austerity measures or campaigned against corruption. Among those featuring in the leaked papers is former EU commissioner and Maltese minister John Dalli, accused of failing to declare a secret offshore company while an MP. Dalli, who resigned as EU health commissioner in 2012 over a bribery scandal, said the company in the British Virgin Islands was "inactive", according to Maltese media. Von der Leyen referenced an EU proposal on the misuse of shell companies which she said is due by the end of the year. "We'll come with an answer to the obvious problems that are still out there," von der Leyen

# Japan's new PM Kishida unveils cabinet

**TOKYO:** Japan's new prime minister Fumio Kishida unveiled his government mixing holdovers with newcomers, after lawmakers voted him the new leader of the world's third-largest economy.

The soft-spoken scion of a Hiroshima political family, 64-year-old Kishida beat popular vaccine chief Taro Kono to win the leadership of the ruling Liberal Democratic Party (LDP) last week. He easily won Monday's vote in parliament approving him as prime minister thanks to the party's commanding majority. Kishida bowed to his fellow lawmakers after the vote, but did not immediately speak. Earlier, he told reporters he was ready for the top job. "I think it will be a new start in its true sense," he said.

"I want to take on challenges with a strong will and firm resolve to face the future." Kishida is widely considered a

safe pair of hands, who commands support from his own faction within the LDP and is not expected to veer significantly from the government's existing policies. His election came after former prime minister Yoshihide Suga, who submitted his resignation on Monday morning, announced he would not stand for the LDP leadership after just one year in office.

Shortly after the parliament vote, Kishida's new cabinet was announced, with more than a dozen fresh faces but holdovers from the Suga government largely populating the most important portfolios. Both Foreign Minister Toshimitsu Motegi and Defence Minister Nobuo Kishi will retain their jobs. Motegi is a Harvard-educated political veteran who has taken the lead in negotiating key trade deals, while Kishi is the brother of former prime minister Shinzo
