

PPP, PML-N making excuses for not providing details of foreign funding: Farrukh



ISLAMABAD: Minister of State for Information and Broadcasting Farrukh Habib said on Monday that Pakistan People's Party (PPP) and Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N) were making excuses for the past four years for not providing details of foreign funding, but PTI would

present facts in front of the nation. Talking to media outside Election Commission of Pakistan, he said according to State Bank of Pakistan, the PPP had 7 accounts whereas Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz had 12 accounts. "These are the people who are hiding behind the delay," he said adding

that the opposition party accounts were used for money laundering. He said that the chartered accountant firm and the PML-N wanted to hide their accounts from the nation, but PTI would present facts in front of the nation. Farrukh said Nawaz Sharif's accounts were also used for money laundering and his party took money from mafia for its own interests. The minister said that the Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz and the Pakistan People's Party had always considered themselves above the law, but now both the parties have fallen in the same pit which they had dug for the PTI. He said now Bilawal Bhutto would now know how many fake accounts his party had. He said that millions of rupees were deposited in the fake accounts belonging to Pakistan People's Party and PML-N. —APP

Sports goods' export up by 11pc in two months

ISLAMABAD: The exports of sports goods witnessed an increase of 11.23 percent during the first two months of ongoing financial year (2021-22) as against the exports of corresponding period of last year. The country exported sports goods worth \$ 50.415 million during July-August (2021-22) against the trade of \$ 45.325 million during July-August (2020-21), showing growth of 11.23 percent, Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS) reported. During the months under review, the export of footballs also increased by 5.25 percent from \$21.828 million last year to \$22.973 million during current year under review while the exports of gloves however witnessed

decline of 1.59 percent from \$12.262 million to \$12.067 million. In addition, the exports of all other sports good however witnessed an increase of 36.85 percent by going up from \$11.235 million to \$15.357 million during the period under review. Meanwhile, on year-on-year basis, the exports of sports products during August 2021 rose by 25.63 percent to \$24.060 million when compare to the exports of \$19.152 million during August 2020, the PBS data revealed. During the period under review, the exports of footballs and gloves also increased by 18.79 and 18.82 percent respectively while the export of all other sports products

increased by 46.48 percent. On month-on-month basis, the exports of sports products went down by 8.71 percent in August 2021 when compared to the exports of \$ 26.355 million in August 2021. During the month under review, the exports of footballs decreased by 7.61 whereas the export

of gloves increased by 2.60 percent, the data revealed. —APP

NGIA to be operational by 2023

ISLAMABAD: The new Gwadar International Airport (NGIA), the \$246m greenfield airport being built at an area of 4,300 acres would be operational by September 2023. According to the official source, the passenger terminal building of the project would be completed by June 2023; work related to air traffic control by March 2023, while the overall construction of the airport would be finished before September 2023. New Gwadar International Airport (NGIA) was being managed and operated by Civil Aviation Authority (CAA). To be owned by a joint venture between Pakistan, Oman, and China, the airport will handle domestic and international operations. The airport development is a part of China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) development, which is a cornerstone of China's One Belt One Road (OBOR) initiative. The biggest in Pakistan and will also become the nation's second airport capable of handling A380 aircraft upon its commissioning in 2022. It was expected to stimulate the development in Gwadar peninsula and boost trade between Pakistan and China. The airport would be



operated under open sky policy and developed under the guidance of the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA). New Gwadar International Airport development timeline New Gwadar International Airport project was initiated as an early harvest high-priority project of the CPEC programme in 2014. It was approved by the Executive Committee of National Economic Council (ECNEC) in January 2015. The project is being funded through a grant agreement signed between China and Pakistan in May 2017. Soil testing on the project site was started in January 2018 and involved drilling of 300 boreholes in

Taiwan's leader says island will not bow to China



TAIPEI: Taiwan will not bow to pressure by Beijing and will defend its democratic way of life, President Tsai Ing-wen said on Sunday, following an alleged spike in incursions by Chinese warplanes into its air defence zone. Self-governed Taiwan's 23 million people live under the constant threat of invasion by China, which views the island as its territory and has vowed to one day seize it, by force if necessary. "The more we achieve, the greater the pressure we face from China," Tsai said in a speech marking Taiwan's National Day, adding: "Nobody can force Taiwan to take the path China has laid out for us." She described Taiwan as "standing on democracy's first line of defence". "We hope for an easing of... relations (with Beijing) and will not act rashly, but there should be absolutely no illusions that the Taiwanese people will bow to pressure," she added. The two sides have been ruled separately since the end of the Chinese civil war in 1949. Tensions have risen to their highest in decades under Chinese President

Xi Jinping, who broke off official communication with Taipei following Tsai's election five years ago and ramped up economic, diplomatic and military pressure. The latest flare-up has been a surge in flights by Chinese fighter jets and nuclear-capable bombers into Taiwan's air defence identification zone (ADIZ). Some 150 sorties were made into the zone in the days surrounding China's own National Day on October 1 — a record number. Three Chinese planes, including two fighter jets, crossed into the zone according to Taiwan's defence ministry. "Complete reunification" Xi has made taking Taiwan a key goal of his leadership which he looks set to extend to a third term in 2022. On Saturday, he declared in a speech that "the complete reunification of our country will be and can be realised". He said he favoured "peaceful reunification" but his words come after months of increased military threats, including the recent surge in air incursions as well as heavily publicised military drills simulating an invasion of Taiwan. —AFP
