**Illegal constructions demolished in Murree:** On the special instructions of Punjab Chief Minister Sardar Usman Buzdar, 117 illegal constructions have been demolished in Murree in the special drive against encroachments. Assistant Commissioner Murree Muhammad Umar Maqbool monitored the operation. According to details, encroachments have been removed from 25 KM long road-side-way (right of way) from National High-

way, Express Highway Sar-Khaitar Toll Plaza to Mouza Masyari. 10 illegally constructed concrete and temporary structures and exterior walls of 8 houses have also been bulldozed. Moreover, 6 illegal constructions have been demolished in Sunny Bank Area. Similarly, 3 illegal construction in Bank Road, 1 in Brewery, 4 in Cart Road, 1 Commercial Structure on Bhurban Road and 2 illegal constructions were bulldozed in Duna. Moreover, buildings were demolished for the Non-payment of Commercialization Fee, qabza mafia and non Payment of 30.6 million in the head of map fee. Assistant Commissioner Murree Umar Maqbool says that indiscriminate action will be taken against illegal constructions in Mur-

## Dengue situation under constant monitoring: Dr Yasmin

**LAHORE:** Punjab Health Minister Dr. Yasmin Rashid said here on Sunday that adequate beds are available for dengue patients and dengue situation is under constant monitoring. The Health Minister said that 107 beds have been reserved at Mayo Hospital, 74 beds at General Hospitals and 226 at the Expo centre. The Minister said that there is still an enhancement capacity of 250 beds for dengue in teaching hospitals of Lahore. Dr. Yasmin Rashid said that dengue situation was being reviewed and beds may be increased as per need.

### Vertical farming to be introduced under CPEC: Gardezi

**LAHORE:** Provincial Minister for Agriculture Syed Hussain Jehanian Gardezi on Sunday said that vertical farming would be introduced in the country with cooperation of China under mega project of China Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC). He said this while talking

to media persons on occasion of Kissan Convention at Muhammad Nawaz Sharif University of Agriculture. The minister stated that government was striving hard to develop new areas for agriculture. About series of Kissan Conventions in the province, the minister stated that it was aimed to create awareness among farmers for maximum cultivation of wheat. Last season, Punjab produced 20.9 million Tonnes. However, increase in wheat production likely this year, he hinted. About Cotton, Gardezi hinted that the dying cotton crop was on its way to revival due to effective policies of the government. The minister observed that sugarcane was cultivated in more area, compared to the area of the last year. Hopefully, nine million tonne sugar would be achieved during this season.



## Lok Virsa annual Lok Mela opens today

According to the official announcement, Lok Virsa annual mega event would be held at Lok Virsa Complex, Garden Avenue, Shakarparian, Islamabad.

The inaugural ceremony of the 7-day event will be held on November 1 which is expected to be graced by Federal Minister for Education, Professional Training Shafiqat Mahmood. The main features will include provincial cultural pavilions from all provinces, GB, AJK including an interna-

tional pavilion, artisans at work, folk songs and dance performances, exotic craft bazaar, cultural nights, folkloric performances, food courts, and many other activities.

As per tradition, the festival will formally open with a 'chadarposhi'/dastarbandi' ceremony, which is a way of proclaiming Lok Virsa's commitment to the high stature that craftspeople and folk artists have in the cultural mainstream.

Culture departments of all provinces, Gilgit-Baltistan, and Azad Jammu & Kashmir, and the diplomatic community have been invited to set up pavilions present-

ing their indigenous folk culture, artisans, folk artists, and traditional cuisine as link nodes of the festival's foundation grid.

Special attractions featuring folk singers, folk entertainers, and other entertaining shows will be organized throughout the festival period duration. Display of traditional folk dances from all over Pakistan will be held in the open-air theatre at intervals.

Folk entertainers and rural musicians are invited from all over the country to participate in the festival.

An exotic craft bazaar with a score of tastefully decorated pavilions offering a variety of knick-knacks souvenirs, antiques, craft items, gems & jewelry, and cultural materials will also be set up erected.

Each province, Gilgit-Baltistan and Azad Jammu & Kashmir will hold its cultural night during Lok Mela in which eminent folk artists and folk performers hailing from the respective province/region will perform live in a concert.

Traditional mouth-watering Pakistani cuisines will be arranged at the venue of the festival. The festival will culminate with a colorful award ceremony which is scheduled to take place on the last day November 7 in which awards will be distributed among the most talented and deserving artisans on the recommendations. —APP
