**DC, ROs discuss Local Bodies elections' arrangements**

— DC says schedule of first phase of LB polls announced and pledges to hold elections in a fair and transparent manner

**MUZAFFARGARH:** Deputy commissioner Muzaffargarh Syed Musa Raza held a meeting with the Returning Officers here Saturday and discussed arrangements for the June 9 polling to be held under phase one of the local body elections.

Presiding over the meeting, DC said that schedule of the first phase of LB polls has been announced and pledged to hold the elections in fair, transparent and in accordance with the code of conduct announced by the Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP).

Raza said that Returning Officers would be provided training, however,

added that they would be able to contact District Election Commissioner Syed Tayyab Zavar, ADCR Muhammad Shah Rukh, and deputy director development Anam Hafeez in case of any problem.

He said that all ROs would perform their duty honestly and no pressure would be tolerated in way of holding elections in fair and transparent manner.

DPO Tariq Wilayat said that a security plan has been prepared and promised that no police officer would be able to have undue influence over the election process. DPO said that officials would perform duty while rising above their personal affiliations.

Detailing election schedule, DEC Tayyab Zavar said that ROs would issue public notice for issuance of nomination papers on Apr 18 and candidates would be able to submit papers from Apr 21 to 25.

Candidates' list would be announced on Apr 26 and scrutiny process would be carried out from Apr 27 to May 9. Candidates would be able to file appeals against rejection of nomination papers from May 10 to 12 and these appeals would be decided till May 14.

List of candidates would be made public on May 16. Candidates would be able to withdraw nominations on May 19 and

the final list of contesting candidates would be made public the same day.

Symbols would be allotted to candidates on May 20 and polling would be held on June 9. Results of the elections would be made public till May 14.

It may be noted that LB polls phase one elections would be held in DG Khan, Layyah, Rajanpur, Bahawalpur, Muzaffargarh, Khanewal, Vehari, Sahiwal, Pakpattan, Toba Tek Singh, Chinot, Khushab, Sialkot, Hafizabad, Mandi Bahauddin, Jhelum and Attock. Rest of the districts would witness elections in the phase II.

**RAWALPINDI:** Water and Sanitation Authority (WASA) Rawalpindi on the directives of the district administration here on Saturday observed anti-dengue day and organized a dengue awareness walk. The walk was attended by Managing Director (MD) WASA Raja Shaikat Mahmood as well as a large number of WASA officers and employees. On the occasion, Raja Shaikat Mahmood briefed that Wasa was creating awareness among people about the danger of dengue and all possible preventive measures were being taken to cope with this disease.

The MD said that WASA was working in collaboration with the Rawalpindi District Administration as well as District Health Department to combat with dengue. Taking under measures, WASA had constituted seven working teams in Rawal Town and Potohar Town, which works on daily basis to eliminate the dengue larvae in Rawalpindi city. Similarly, accumulated water in streets and roads are sucked through sucking and jet machines, he added.

Moreover, the sewerage staff was also working on cleaning drains and small outlets besides manholes to improve drainage system in order to prevent the disease. WASA employees are well trained by the health department who possess the capability of differentiating between larvae and dengue mosquitoes, he informed. Working in the field, the field staff if detects larvae from any house, it is removed and the house is supplied clean drinking

**Expert urges public to donate blood for 'Thalassemia' patients**

**ISLAMABAD:** Health experts on Saturday urged the public to continue donating blood throughout Ramadan to help manage the blood transfusion needs of thalassemia patients.

Air Vice Marshal (Retd) Aftab Hussain, Chief Administrator Sundas Foundation Islamabad, while talking to PTV News on Saturday said that thalassemia patients were dependent on regular blood transfusions to stay alive in addition to expensive therapies and other medical management.

He said thalassemia was a major healthcare challenge placing huge psychological and financial stress on the affected families and putting extra burden on the national healthcare delivery system.

"The only solution to the miseries of the thalassemia patients is a successful bone marrow transplant, which is possible only if the tissue matches", he added.

A healthy person can donate blood after every two months, he said, adding that healthy people particularly the youngsters have to donate blood on a regular basis three to four times a year.

He also demanded of the government and health sector to ensure sufficient resources and facilities to the quality and effectiveness of blood collection. —APP

**NHMP striving to minimise accidents on Motorways, Highways**

**LAHORE:** To control and minimize the number of accidents on federalized highways and

motorways, the National Highway and Motorway Police (NHMP) has been actively trying by ensuring strict enforcement of traffic laws. Now 16 percent reduction in

accidents was witnessed. An official of NHMP told APP on Saturday that strict enforcement of law under National Highways Safety Ordinance 2000 and imposition of fines under section 79 of NHSP, 2000 against violators specially involved in careless driving, over speeding, lane violation etc were among the steps taken to control accidents.

He said that FIRs under section 279 and other relevant sections of Pakistan Penal Code were also lodged against the violators

found in rash or negligent driving. The official said that extensive use of day and night speed checking cameras was being done to avoid accidents due to over speeding. Moreover he said that checking of tyres with treads and air pressure gauges were also being done at toll plazas to prevent tyre burst accidents.

He said that anti-dozing points were established to avoid accidents due to dozing at the wheel. In addition to that surprise and random checking of vehicles at night time to check the physical status of drivers was being done. He said that road safety seminars and walks

at beat and sector level were arranged on road side hotel/pumps and truck stations to inform drivers regarding road safety.

The NHMP official said that seminars, walks/counseling and briefing sessions

were also conducted for the drivers regarding mechanical fitness of the vehicles.

He said that briefings and education regarding road safety to road users at toll plazas as well as through Mobile Education Unit. Surprise checking and patrolling by the sector commander was being done and strict action taken against lane violators. Briefings were given and education imparted at different institutes/school/colleges as the youngsters were the major users of bikes, he said adding special emphasis was given on enforcement against underage riding and overloading on motor bikes.

He said that strict action was being taken against motorcyclists for not wearing a helmet, dangerous riding, one wheeling, triple riding, without black/ side view mirror, one way violation etc.

**Crackdown against revenue defaulters**

**MULTAN:** The district administration held crackdown against revenue defaulters to recover tax money on Saturday, according to official release.

A defaulter identified as Umar Hyay hailing from Muzffarabad was arrested for not paying agricultural tax.

Assistant Commissioner City Khwaja Umair said it had recovered more than Rs. 500,000 in the wake of agricultural income tax long been pending with defaulters.

He said the recovery task was delivered by high ups, adding that no lethargy would be committed to meet the target. —APP
