

Education department introduces online tracking system in country

MULTAN: In an innovative move, the School Education Department, South Punjab has launched an online students performance tracking system, abbreviated as SPeTS.

"It would enable all the stakeholders including teachers, parents and the department to keep a track on every student's performance with ultimate aim of taking appropriate actions where required", said a release issued by the Directorate of Public Relations here on Wednesday. All particulars, including not only those related to the student but also concerning the

family members such as academic, professional and financial details of parents and siblings would be fed in the system which would help teachers see the student in totality. Every teacher would be required to provide feedback on individual student, with particular focus on the strengths and weaknesses in the given subject, and then update it every three months thus enabling the supervisors to see how the student's progress can be improved. Result sheets for the monthly assessment and annual exam etc. would also be kept in the system to avoid any concealment on the part of the students. The system would also capture general details on behavior of the students as well such as attendance, discipline,

punctuality, cleanliness, and personal hygiene etc.

Another hallmark of the SPeTS is that it would also record details pertaining to physical and mental health and general well-being of all learners so that symptoms are detected in time for subsequent treatment to avoid lifelong illnesses, added the release.


Furthermore, it is being linked with the data of health department so that a referral to an appropriate medical facility could also be generated.

Palestinian shot dead in Israeli operation in West Bank

JERICHO: A Palestinian was killed when Israeli forces stormed a refugee camp in the occupied West Bank in what the army called a "counter-terrorism" operation that sparked violent riots.

The deadly shooting was the latest in a wave of bloodshed in the West Bank and Israel as Ramadan and the Jewish Passover overlapped this month. The Palestinian health ministry said 20-year-old Ahmed Ibrahim Oweidat "succumbed to critical wounds sustained by live bullets to the head, at dawn today in Aqabat Jaber camp" near Jericho.

Two other men were wounded by live fire when the "undercover" forces raided the camp overnight, the official Palestinian news agency Wafa said. Israel's army said in a statement that soldiers had conducted an overnight operation in Aqabat "to apprehend wanted suspects". "During the operational activity, dozens of Palestinians violently rioted and attacked the soldiers," it said, adding that no Israeli troops were hurt.

"The rioters burned tyres and hurled rocks and Molotov cocktails at the soldiers. The soldiers responded with riot dispersal means and live ammunition." Clashes between Israeli forces and Palestinians are common in the West Bank, a territory occupied by Israel since 1967, but recent weeks have seen a surge in unrest. —APP

Myanmar's Suu Kyi handed 5 year jail term for corruption

MYANMAR: A court in military-ruled Myanmar sentenced deposed leader Aung San Suu Kyi to five years in jail on Wednesday after finding her guilty in the first of 11 corruption cases against her, a source with knowledge of the proceedings said. The Nobel laureate and figurehead of Myanmar's opposition to military rule is charged with at least 18 offences carrying combined maximum jail terms of nearly 190 years, all but killing off any chance of a political comeback. The judge in the capital, Naypyitaw, handed down the verdict within moments of the court convening and gave no explanation, said the source, who declined to be identified because the trial is being held behind closed doors, with information restricted. Suu Kyi, who has attended all of her hearings, was displeased with the outcome and would appeal, the source said. —APP

Moldova urges calm after blasts in breakaway region

CHISINAU: Ex-Soviet Moldova urged citizens to stay calm and stepped up security after a series of blasts in a Russian-backed separatist region raised fears of a spillover from the war in Ukraine.

The breakaway region of Transnistria said there were explosions on Monday and Tuesday in the security ministry, a military unit and a radio tower belonging to Russia, and called them "terrorist attacks". Transnistria is located about 80 kilometres from Moldova's capital Chisinau, bordering western Ukraine.

"We urge citizens to keep calm and feel safe," President Maia Sandu said after a meeting of the national security council. She recommended stepped up patrols and vehicle checks near a buffer zone with Transnistria, tighter public safety measures and security checks on critical infrastructure. The conflict in Ukraine has sparked fears in Moldova that it could become Russia's next target. Ukraine accused Russia of staging the blasts with presidential aide Mykhailo Podolyak tweeting that Moscow "wants to destabilise the Transnistrian region and hints Moldova should wait for 'guests'".

The Kremlin expressed "concern" over the explosions. Russian state news agency RIA Novosti quoted a source in the Transnistria government as saying that attackers had entered from Ukraine. The Organisation for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE), the world's largest security body, condemned "all attempts to destabilise (the) situation" in Transnistria and its buffer zone. Two explosions hit a radio tower re-broadcasting Russian stations near the Ukrainian border early on Tuesday, the interior ministry of the breakaway region said.

It also said offices of the state security ministry in the main city Tiraspol were hit by what appeared to be a grenade-launcher attack on Monday evening, a public holiday for Orthodox
