

'Court remarked this court should not be entangled in the committees'

ISLAMABAD: Islamabad High Court (IHC) has remarked defence minister is subordinate to whom. The court remarked, "either Prime Minister (PM) should say he is helpless and if he is not helpless then the constitution holds him responsible. PM should say before this court so that court could take action against some one. The petitions against non recovery of missing persons including Mudassar Naroo came up for hearing before a single bench of IHC presided over by Chief Justice (CJ) IHC Athar Minallah here Friday. Deputy Attorney General (DAG) told the court federal cabinet has constituted

committee comprising ministers in the matter of missing persons. The CJ IHC remarked "read out what this court had written in its previous order. It was written in this order missing persons be recovered and presented. Where they are. DAG told the court federal government has constituted committee. Investigating agencies are also making their efforts. The court remarked this court should not be entangled in the committees. Tell us if the implementation has been made or otherwise. Where is federal government action. Court will not accept eye wash. At present the people are being lifted daily. No one is there to ask about it. The court had ordered to issue notice

to Pervez Musharraf and all the Prime ministers who came after him. These notices and affidavits are where. This is the most important matter. The attitude of state is sorrowful in this regard. Have the meetings of the committees set up by the federal government taken place. The court had ordered if its orders are not implemented then the present and previous interior ministers should appear before the court. where is interior minister. Is the court's order being implemented. Will it look good that court summons chief executive. The court had ordered that order be implemented. All the governments are defying constitution and their oath.

The court while addressing the counsel of the missing persons remarked you had diverted attention to an important aspect during the previous hearing. There are 10 cases like this that people went missing and later it became known they were tried and were awarded punishment. Col (Retd) Inam ul Rahim advocate told the court we came to know later from jail that some of them were tried and were awarded death sentence. They were awarded punishment under official secret act. The court inquired if the families of those who were put to trial did not know about it. The defence counsel no they did not know about it.

Their families came to know about it from jail later. The court remarked federal cabinet has constituted a committee. Although it is equal to non but some step may have been taken. The court remarked this court should hold whom responsible of these enforced disappearances. Tell us if there is state within state here. Police, IB and agencies of armed forces are alleged. Inam ul Rahim told the court should hold Prime Minister responsible who knows all about it. The court remarked tell us about one among these cases who has lifted him. Anma Masood Janjua told the court notice should be issued to defence minister. —APP

Quetta Metrological Centre warns flood in northeast Balochistan
The Metrological Center Quetta on Friday said that thunderstorms with isolated heavy falls are expected in the northeast Balochistan that may generate flood-like situations in its catchment areas. "Heavy downpour is expected in Sherani, Zhob, Musakhel, Qila Saifullah, Loralai, Duki, Barkhan, Kohlu, Bolan, and its surrounding areas during the evening," said the MCQ referring to the weather forecast for next 24 hours. However, dusty/dust rising winds are also expected in central and southern parts of the province. Heavy falls may generate floods in the catchment areas of Northeast Balochistan. After the introduction of this system from June 17 to June 20, dusty winds have started blowing in Pak-Iran and Pak-Afghan border areas. An alert has been issued by the PDMA for the Deputy Commissioners of the districts under the expected system. The PDMA directed the Deputy Commissioners of the concerned districts to keep the necessary staff ready during the rains. The PDMA has also issued flood warnings for Lower Balochistan along with Takhte-e-Salman and Harnai Range. —APP



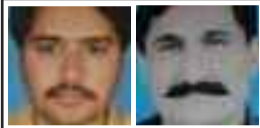

US condemns BJP members' 'offensive comments' about the Prophet

NEW YORK: US State Department spokesperson Ned Price has condemned the "offensive comments" about Prophet Muhammad (Peace Be Upon Him) by members of India's ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP). On June 5, BJP spokesperson Nupur Sharma and another party leader, Naveen Kumar Jindal, had made disrespectful remarks about the Prophet (PBUH) and after worldwide condemnation, the BJP had to distance itself from their statements, announcing disciplinary action against the duo. The party had suspended Sharma and expelled Jindal. Meanwhile, an uproar was witnessed over the remarks across the world and within India, as Prime Minister Narendra Modi's party faced condemnation in Muslim countries and other nations. Muslims took to the streets across Asia, including India, where protesters faced a crackdown by Indian authorities. According to a July 13 Dawn report, police in the Indian state of Uttar Pradesh had made at least 300 arrests in connection with the unrest after protests erupted there early in the month and razed the houses of several people over their alleged involvement in demonstrations. Clashes had broken out between Muslims and Hindus in some cases and between police and protesters in several areas, the report said. During Price's press briefing on Thursday, a journal-

ist raised the issue of the BJP members' offensive remarks and the subsequent demolition of Muslims' houses. "Would you like to say something about these hate crimes committed by [the] Indian government against Muslims and other minorities?" he asked the State Department spokesperson. In reply, Price said, "Well, this is something that we've condemned. We condemn the offensive comments made by two BJP officials, and we were glad to see that the party publicly condemned those comments." He further said the US regularly engaged with the Indian government at senior levels on human rights concerns, including freedom of religion, of belief, and "we encourage India to promote respect for human rights". The secretary added: "The Indian people and the American people, we believe in the same values: human dignity, human respect, equality of opportunity, and the freedom of religion or belief. These are fundamental tenets, these are fundamental values within any democracy, and we speak up for them around the world." In a subsequent question, Price was asked about any steps being taken by the US with regards to India and other Asian nations continuing to purchase oil from Russia against the backdrop of Moscow's offensive in Ukraine and consequent sanctions imposed on it by the

Three Palestinians shot dead in Israeli army raid in Jenin



JERUSALEM: Three Palestinians were killed and 10 others were wounded on Friday during an Israeli army raid in Jenin, in the occupied West Bank. The three men were killed when the Israeli forces opened fire on a vehicle in which they were travelling, according to the Palestinian news agency Wafa. "Fierce clashes" then ensued in the area, with Israeli troops firing at Palestinians, wounding 10, Wafa reported. An AFP photographer said a white vehicle riddled with bullet holes was in the area, where Israeli forces have stepped up operations in recent

months. The photographer said he saw the bodies of the three men at the morgue in Jenin. They were identified as Yusef Salah, 23, Baraa Lahluh, 24, and Laith Abu Srur, 24, all from Jenin. Locals inspect the bullet-riddled vehicle where three Palestinians were killed in an operation by Israeli forces in Jenin in the occupied West Bank on Friday. The Israeli army said in a statement that its troops had been conducting an operation in Jenin to search for weapons at two different locations. The soldiers had come under fire as they arrived at the first location and

they retaliated before identifying a suspicious vehicle on the side of the road on their way to the second location, it said. "Shots were fired from the vehicle at the soldiers, who neutralised the terrorists who fired at them," the army claimed, adding that they found weapons, including two M-16 assault rifles and cartridges at the scene. The Israeli army has ramped up raids in and around the occupied West Bank's Jenin camp, a stronghold of Palestinian armed factions. Palestinian-American journalist Shireen Abu Akleh, a prominent TV reporter with Al Jazeera, was shot dead last month

in Jenin while she was covering an Israeli army operation. The Palestinian Authority, Al Jazeera and Qatar, where the channel is based, accused the Israeli army of killing the journalist. Several journalistic probes have also pointed in the same direction. A Palestinian investigation said the reporter — who was wearing a bullet-proof vest with "press" written on it and a helmet when she was shot — was killed in what it described as a war crime. Israel has denied the allegations, arguing that she could have been killed by a Palestinian gunman, but later said it could not rule out the possibility that it was Israeli soldiers. The Israeli army has not yet released its conclusion following an internal investigation. The Israeli police had launched the internal investigation following an international outcry after Abu Akleh's coffin was almost dropped when police attacked the pallbearers during her funeral. On Thursday, the Israeli police closed the probe into violence at the funeral — without however releasing any findings. State Department

spokesman Ned Price said the United States was seeking more information about the probe into the funeral. "Certainly, to us, typically these investigations — the findings of them — are released publicly," Price told reporters in Washington. US President Joe Biden is expected in Israel and
