

AC suspends Dar arrest warrants, orders not to arrest him on return

ISLAMABAD: Accountability Court (AC) Islamabad has suspended permanent arrest warrants of PML-N senior leader and former Finance Minister (FM) Ishaq Dar till October 07 ordering that he should not be arrested on his arrival in Pakistan.

The court remarked it will see the matter of cancellation of warrants when Ishaq Dar returns to Pakistan.

The petition against permanent arrest warrants of Ishaq Dar came up for hearing before AC Islamabad led by judge Muhammad Bashir Friday.

Qazi Misbah counsel for Ishaq Dar appeared in the court and opened up arguments.

Judge of AC inquired from counsel of



Ishaq Dar that either Ishaq Dar was sick or there was some other problem.

The counsel for Ishaq Dar informed the court about the reasons behind issuing arrest warrants of PML-N leader praying permanent arrest warrants of Ishaq Dar be cancelled. The counsel for Ishaq Dar assured the court Ishaq Dar will appear straight in the court after his plane lands at airport.

The learned judge inquired where is prosecutor.

The NAB prosecutor told the court Afzal Qureshi has gone to Saudi Arabia for performance of Umrah.

After short break, the court suspended the permanent arrest warrants of Ishaq Dar. The court while giving chance to Ishaq

Dar to surrender ordered Ishaq Dar be not arrested on his arrival in Pakistan.

Judge Muhammad Bashir remarked during the hearing of the case we will see the matter of cancellation of arrest warrants when Ishaq Dar returns to Pakistan.

Some days earlier Ishaq Dar had filed petition in the accountability court against his arrest warrants.

Qazi Misbah counsel for Ishaq Dar had taken the plea NAB should withdraw the arrest warrants of former finance minister Ishaq Dar.

Qazi Misbah requested the court that Ishaq Dar is ready to surrender and he be not arrested on his arrival in Pakistan. On line

What diplomatic, legal steps taken in Dr Aafia case: IHC

ISLAMABAD: The Islamabad High Court (IHC) has ordered that foreign office should arrange meeting between its counsel and Dr Fouzia Siddiqui, sister of Dr Aafia Siddiqui imprisoned in US jail and government should inform the court what steps can it take at legal and diplomatic fronts in Dr Aafia Siddiqui case.

A single bench of IHC led by Justice Sardar Ijaz Ishaq Khan gave these remarks during the course of hearing of the case pertaining to the health and release of Dr Aafia Siddiqui imprisoned in US jail Friday.

The petitioner Fouzia Siddiqui appeared in the court along with her lawyer Dr Sajid Qureshi.

Officer of foreign office told the court the decision of awarding punishment to Dr Aafia Siddiqui given by US court in 2010 has not been provided to government of Pakistan. The court remarked it is surprising that copy of US court's decision has not been received so far in foreign office during 12 years. —AFP

Russians flee Ukraine war call-up as soldiers mobilisation kicks off

KYIV, Ukraine: Moscow began its mandatory troop call-up on Thursday to try to bolster a stumbling war effort in Ukraine, with authorities saying thousands had volunteered even as Russian men fled the country to avoid being forced to fight. Amateur footage posted on social media since President Vladimir Putin ordered the mobilisation of reservists on Wednesday purported to show hundreds of Russian citizens across the country responding to military summons.

The call-up came as Moscow-held regions of Ukraine are to vote in coming days on whether to become part of Russia in referendums that have been called an unlawful land grab by Kyiv and its allies.

Moscow took these steps after Ukrainian forces seized back most of the northeastern Kharkiv

region, which has been seen as a possible turning point in the seven-month war that had fallen into stalemate.

The Russian military said on Thursday that at least 10,000 people had volunteered to fight in 24 hours since the order, but men also rushed to leave Russia before they were made to join. "I don't want to go to the war," a man named Dmitri, who had flown to Armenia with just one small bag, told AFP. "I don't want to die in this senseless war. This is a fratricidal war."

Military-aged men made up the majority of those arriving off the latest flight from Moscow at the Armenian airport and many were reluctant to speak. Yerevan has become a major destination for Russians fleeing since war began on February 24, drawing fierce international opposition that has aimed to isolate Russia.

US Secretary of State Antony Blinken on Thursday demanded Putin be held to account as he faced Russia in a Security Council session in which the UN catalogued abuses in Ukraine. "We cannot -- we will not -- let President Putin get away with it," Blinken told the Security Council in a special session as leaders met at the United Nations.

Russian Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov -- whom Blinken has refused to meet individually since the

February invasion -- lashed out at Western accusations. "There's an attempt today to impose on us a completely different narrative about Russian aggression as the origin of this tragedy," Lavrov told the Security Council.

The confrontation on the diplomatic stage escalated as Kremlin-installed officials in Ukrainian regions controlled by Moscow's forces vowed on Thursday to press ahead with annexation polls this week. Four Russian-occupied regions

of Ukraine -- Donetsk and Lugansk in the east and Kherson and Zaporizhzhia in the south -- announced that they would hold the votes over five days, beginning on Friday. Vladimir Saldo, the Moscow-installed head of Kherson, which fell early into the Russian invasion, said the referendum would go ahead in his region regardless of the criticism. "The date has been set. We have the green light. Voting begins tomorrow and nothing can prevent this,"

he told Russian state-run media.

"People have been waiting and they're demanding that this vote is held soon," he added. —AFP
