

Parents' cooperation inevitable to make Pakistan polio-free, says Commissioner

MULTAN (APP): Commissioner Multan division, Engineer Aamir Khattak said that the parents' cooperation was inevitable to make the country polio-free. He expressed these views while presiding over a meeting to review the performance of the health department here on Saturday. He asked the citizens to get their children administered anti-polio drops to save them from lifelong disability. He warned that strict legal action will be taken against parents who refuse to administer polio drops to their kids. The anti-polio campaign will start from October 24 and continue till Oct 28 in Multan in connection with world polio day. Commissioner Aamir Khattak tasked the

health department to complete all the arrangements regarding this. Exactly 4,248 teams will administer polio drops to more than 9 lac children across the district. Commissioner also ordered speeding up anti-dengue activities. The health officials briefing the Commissioner said that 755 confirmed cases of dengue were reported across Multan division this year. CEO Health Dr Ali Mahdi said that the polio camps have also been established in public places including the general bus stand. He said that the staff showing unsatisfactory performance have been replaced and the performance of all teams will be fully monitored. Additional Deputy Commissioner General Rizwan Nazir, Assistant

Commissioner Ayub Bukhari, Director Health Services Dr. Waseem Ramzi, Dr. Ataur Rahman, and other officials were also present. **DG MDA for effective awareness drive to facilitate citizens** Director General Multan Development Authority (MDA) Qaisar Saleem has directed the officials concerned to speed up the public information and awareness campaign to make people aware of MDA's performance. He instructed the heads of all directorates to make full use of social media to share with the public the performance report of the last four years as well as the measures taken in public interest. Instructions were is-

sued to nominate a focal person regularly in all directorates to speed up the social media campaign. Qaisar Saleem directed the heads of all the directorates to send the record to the IT Directorate on daily basis for public awareness and information sharing with the public. Hundreds take to streets in Iran's Zahedan over killings

PARIS: Hundreds of demonstrators took to the streets of the southeastern Iranian city of Zahedan, three weeks after over 90 people were reportedly killed in "Bloody Friday" protests. "Death to the dictator", the protesters, mostly young men, chanted on Friday in reference to supreme leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei outside a police station, in footage widely shared on social media.

According to Iran Human Rights, an Oslo-based group, Iranian forces had killed 93 people who had gathered at the same location on September 30. Zahedan, the capital of Sistan-Baluchestan province, is one of the few Sunni-majority cities in Iran. "Death to Khamenei" and "Unity, unity", the protesters shouted after Friday prayers in a video shared by Radio Farda, a US-funded station.

The slogans echoed those chanted in nationwide protests over Mahsa Amini, an Iranian woman of Kurdish origin who died in custody on Sept 16. The police chief of Sistan-Baluchestan, Ahmad Taheri, said 57 "rioters" were arrested during Friday's protests. A news agency said "thugs and rioters" had gathered after Friday prayers at Makki Mosque — headed by influential Sunni cleric Molavi Abdol

Hamid. It said they "shouted slogans and threw rocks at shops, cars and banks", noting that "leaders and instigators" had been identified and investigations were underway. Amini, 22, died three days after falling into a coma following her arrest in Tehran by the morality police for an alleged breach of the country's dress code for women. Two weeks later, violence erupted in Zahedan during protests that were triggered by anger over the reported rape of a teenage girl by a police commander in the region. A human rights group called on Friday for Iranian climber Elnaz Rekabi to be protected after she was reportedly placed under house arrest for competing abroad without a hijab. Rekabi competed in South Korea last week without wearing a headscarf. Citing an "informed source", BBC Persian said Rekabi had been put under pressure to make a "forced confession" after her return on Wednesday from the Asian Championships in sports climbing in Seoul. The 33-year-old was given a hero's welcome on her return to Tehran by supporters who raucously applauded her action, but the source told BBC Persian that she did not go home after arriving at the airport. "She was held at the national Olympics academy under the watch of plain-


clothes officers until she met the minister," it said, referring to Sports Minister Hamid Sajjadi. Rekabi had been threatened with the seizure of 100 million rials (\$312,000) worth of her family's property unless she made the "forced confession", the source was quoted as saying. On Friday, a New York-based human rights group called on the International Federation of Sport Climbing to do more to protect her. The federation "should engage with rights organisations to protect pro climber #ElnazRekabi and all Iranian athletes", the Center for Human Rights in Iran said on Twitter. "Don't take the government in Iran's word at face value — it has a documented history of detaining, maiming and killing those who oppose it." Fears had been raised about the fate of Rekabi after friends had reportedly been unable to contact her following the end of her participation in the competition in Seoul. News website Iran Wire said the head of Iran's climbing federation had "tricked" her into entering the Iranian embassy in Seoul, promising her safe passage to Iran if she handed over her phone and passport. He also appealed to parents to cooperate with polio teams and get their children vaccinated against the deadly disease. He also asked people to not pay heed to negative propaganda against polio and play a role in eradicating polio from the entire district. He said the arrangements had already been reviewed in meetings with all stakeholders to make the entire drive a success and conduct it in a peaceful manner. —APP
